

Certificate of RoHS Compliance

The European Union RoHS Directive 2002/95/EC requires the following six heavy metals and heavy metal compounds to be eliminated or drastically reduced:

- Lead (Pb)
- Mercury (Hg)
- Cadmium (Cd)
- Hexavalent Chromium (Cr +6)
- Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB)
- Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE)

Based on our ingredients lists (or MSDS) submitted by our suppliers, the six heavy metals listed above are not employed in the manufacture of Blue-White products. We would expect low trace levels of those heavy metals that may be present as impurities to be within threshold limits.

This statement applies to the following:

- A. All products originally manufactured and released for sale on or after July 1, 2006.
- B. All refurbished, reconditioned or otherwise returned products which exhibit an original manufacture and sold date of July 1, 2006 or later.

This is to certify that to the best of our knowledge, all products manufactured and shipped by Blue-White Industries as of July 01, 2006 do not contain radioactive compounds and meet the European Union RoHS Directive 2002/95/EC for the Reduction of Hazardous Substances.
